Posters should be clearly laid out and designed for a general audience, with technical material (if any) made available is requested. The aim is to have posters that can inform the public and benefit city and facilities managers, agricultural managers as well as persons from regulatory agencies.

The goals of the event are to clarify the purposes and uses of water monitoring data, capture perspectives of multiple sectors (data generators and users), feature exemplary programs and projects, and help focus tasks for working toward a regional monitoring program (RMP). This will be an opportunity for you to share your knowledge, experience, and expertise with others in attendance.

The forum will focus on networking and sharing new technologies and approaches that will improve the efficiency and comparability of water quality monitoring programs today and in the future. We are committed to bringing together key decision-makers, agricultural coalitions, irrigation districts, individuals, and city and facilities managers responsible for monitoring programs, as well as those responsible for on the ground implementation of management practices for protecting and preserving water quality.

Also, we will have breakout sessions that give attention to quality assurance and quality control requirements (QA/QC), database systems, presenting monitoring data for public access, and funding for a regional monitoring program (RMP). The forum will provide an excellent opportunity for sharing information and experiences among the attendees.
